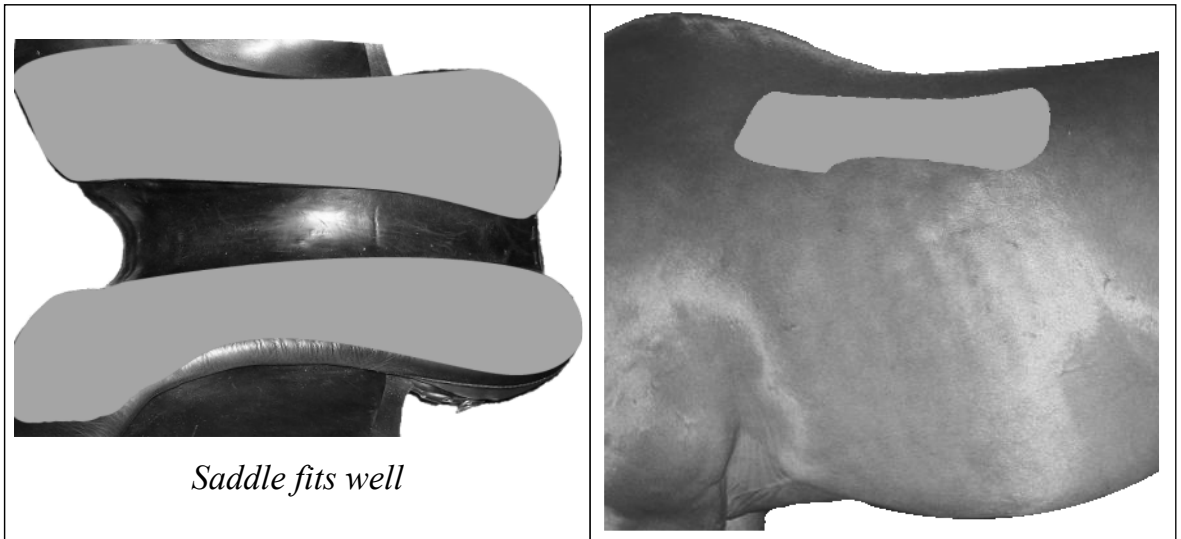

### Fitting Problems



A saddle which fits well sits, flatly, against the horse's back. It contacts the horse's back all the way from the front to the back. At the front, back, and edges, a slight flare lifts the edge of the saddle away from the horse.
